Compliance with laws etc.

Complying with applicable national and regional laws, rules, etc., also, we respect international codes of conduct.

# Prohibition of corruption and bribery

Not engaging in any corrupt acts that abuse our own or a third party's authority or position in the course of our duties, including bribery, embezzlement, insider trading, extortion of benefits, and improper bidding. This includes complicity.

### Protection of personal information

Be respectful and protect the privacy. In handling personal information, comply with all relevant laws and regulations.

### Protection of information assets

Always protect information assets and prevent information leakage, falsification, theft, etc. All relevant personals and corporates shall comply relevant laws and regulations more by which shall strive to securely manage information.

## Respect to the international human rights standards

To understand and respect the human rights set out in the "International Bill of Human Rights" and the "International Labor Organization's (ILO) Declaration on Fundamental Principles and Rights at Work" as a minimum.
